Big Idea of the Message: We break free the pull of this world by having a heart that is open and receptive like a child, surrendering our wants, wanting God's generosity to be lavished on others and serving rather than being served.

- 6. How does the misguided approach of the disciples beginning in Matthew 20:20 parallel your own approach to God and the Christian life?
